

Reader Rights

- Free readership rights to open access article(s) immediately upon publication.

Copyrights

- BioProcessing Journal (BPJ) retains copyrights but will grant open access authors generous usage privileges (see below).

Reuse/Republication Rights

- BioProcessing Journal will feature selected articles (particularly those designated as open access) in the biweekly e-newsletter, Techno-Blast.
- If the authors of the open access article:
 - Wish to republish the article elsewhere, authors must gain permission from BioProcessing Journal and include an acknowledgement that we will provide. An example would be:
 - Republished with permission. Expediting Clinical Batch Production of Viral-Vectored Vaccines and Gene Therapy Products. Priyabrata Pattnaik, PhD, and George Adams, MS. BioProcessing Journal, Vol. 12/ No. 3. © 2013 BioProcessing Journal.
 - Want to re-use portions of the article in other literature or PowerPoint presentations (e.g., a table or figure), they should credit the article appropriately (e.g., by including the article citation). See examples above, substituting “Used” for “Republished.”
 - Determine that article revisions are needed, they must be handled by BioProcessing Journal (working with the master files). Minor changes, as determined by the managing editor, will be performed at no cost.

Article Reprints

- Open access authors can make unlimited reprints or paper copies of the article PDF.
 - If the authors wish to order high-quality reprints from BioProcessing Journal, we will be happy to facilitate it. BPJ production staff can work up the specs, obtain a quote from the printer, and invoice the author. Prepayment must be made prior to printing. Reprints will be shipped to the authors.

Author Posting Rights of Electronic File (PDF)

- Open access authors may post (self-archive) their article PDF file to any website or indexing site and distribute the file as they see fit (e.g., email to colleagues, make available to repositories such as PubMed Central).

Automatic Posting of Article on BioProcessing Journal Website

- Article will be made available for free viewing and PDF downloading on the BioProcessing Journal website.

Machine Readability

- All articles are added to the DOI® (digital object identifier) System and CrossRef citation-linking network.
- BioProcessing Journal will make the full article text and select keywords visible to website metadata crawlers, which will facilitate effective search engine optimization and web browsing – all designed to help scientists worldwide find the articles.
